Sermon Title - Things God Never Said:
"It Doesn't Matter What You Believe."



ICEBREAKER:

John 14:6, Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the father except through me." How do you react to this verse when you think about people in your life who don't know Jesus?

What are the people on your "My Three" card (non-Christians) like? How are they similar and different from you?

Are they typically dedicated to other religions (Islam, Judaism, Hinduism, etc.) or are they essentially non-religious?

What can you do to reach your people on the "My Three" card with the Gospel?



THINK & READ:

Examining three aspects of Jesus:

1 His Ministry

Have someone read Mark 2:15-17.

What does this passage mean? What does this passage mean to you?

2 His Resurrection

Have someone read Acts 3:15.

Why is Jesus' crucifixion important? Why is Jesus' resurrection important?

3 His Eternal Message

Have someone read Romans 3:22-24.

How is a relationship with Jesus different from religion?

Religion = DO

Relationship = DONE

God doesn't love you because of what you do. God loves you because of who he is.

Do you struggle to accept that God loves you no matter what you do? Why is this a difficult truth to accept? Why does it matter what you believe?
