Sermon Title - Noah and the Ark



ICEBREAKER:

Since today's topic is Noah and the Ark, let's start out by talking about animals. Tell us about your favorite pet.

Noah saved two of every kind of bird, of every kind of animal and of every kind of creature that moves along the ground. Which animal or creature do you wish had been left off the ark?



THINK & READ:

Let's take a chunk of time to read through the biblical account of Noah's ark. There are many more details than you'll find in the children's books.

(This story is pretty long, so break up the reading between the people in your Home Group)

Read Genesis 6:5-8:22 & Genesis 9:8-16 (lots of Bible reading today!)

What is something new about Noah and the Ark that you never knew before?

What do you think God is trying to teach you in this story?

Noah's story is a story of God's judgement. How can God both judge sinners AND rescue sinners from judgment?

(God is 100% righteous and just and 100% loving, merciful, and gracious)

What do we need in order to be rescued from God's judgment?

(JESUS! - faith in Him)
